

Smallpipe Reed Dimensions

I can make reeds to suit chanters that are not listed on the website but I need information.

I would prefer to have a reed that is known to have been good that I can examine and measure.

Alternatively my specification chart can be followed and the information sent to me.

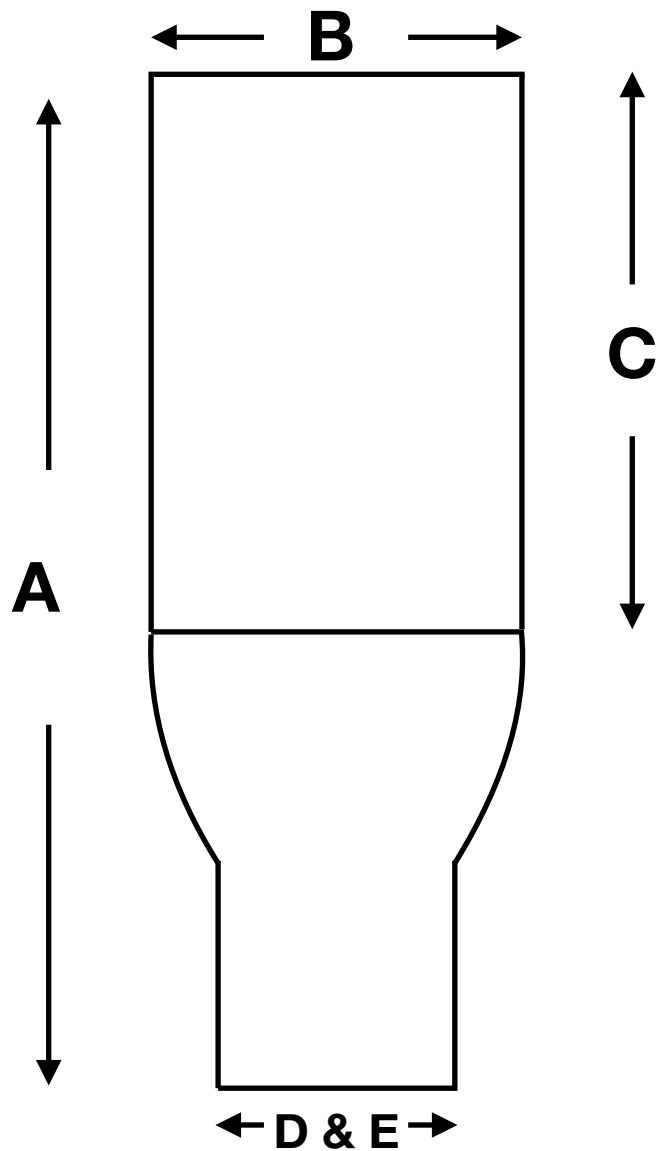
The best method is to send me the chanter, although this adds postal charges to the final bill.

Under the current import/export situation I cannot accept chanters from outside the UK.

Due to the work required completion time for reeds can vary depending on any problems encountered and how much work I have at that time.

Reeds must be paid for before work commences.

Smallpipe Reed Dimensions



A	Overall Length
B	Width of Blades
C	Length of blades From binding
D	External diameter of staple
E	Internal diameter of staple
F	Pitch of reed when sucked through the staple end

Before sucking the reed to establish pitch make sure you check the reed for debris.
